TAKE SERVICES OF SKILLED AND CERTIFIED SECURITY GUARDS - SKILLS DEVELOPMENT MINISTER URGES INDUSTRY

Sh. Sarbananda Sonowal, Minister of State for Skill Development, Entrepreneurship, Youth Affairs and Sports (Independent Charge) urged industry and corporate to take the services of Security Guards, housekeeping and people at the shop floor who are skilled and certified as per the parameters set under National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF)



Hon'ble Minister made this statement at the Global Skills Summit-2014 organized by FICCI at New Delhi on September 04, 2014. He said that it was important through both macro and micro polices to create a pull factor which attract and also enforces the people to get skilled to get into

employment. He further said that development Skill has been identified as a priority of the Government and Prime Minister Narendra Modi spelled it out in detail in his Independence Day address. He also suggested appropriate certified skilled workforce in tendering of manpower intensive project.

He emphasized the urgent need to revisit the Minimum Wages Act to align wages to levels defined in the National Skill Oualification Framework.

Kunwar Vikram Singh Chairman of Security Sector Skill Development Council applauded the statement of the Hon'ble Minister. He said that SSSDC under NSDC trained and certified more than one lakh Security Guards as per the Skills National Oualification Framework. He said that the Government of West Bengal, Haryana, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh have already commenced the training of security guards as per the NSQF.

He said that in the next one year more than 2 lakh Skilled and Certified Security will be available for deployment to protect industrial and corporate establishments throughout country. He further said that Controlling Authorities appointed under Private Security Agencies Regulation functioning under Home Departments of the State Government should ensure that security guards working within their respective State must be trained as per the NSQF and certified by the Security Sector Skill Development Council. He said that SSSDC has already accredited more than 300 Training Providers for training the Security Guards and five Assessment Bodies have been accredited to certify the Security Guards trained by such Training Providers.

SECURITY KNOWLEDGE & SKILLS MADE MANDATORY FOR PG STUDENTS OF PUNE UNIVERSITY

NSDC to sign MOU with University of Pune to launch its dream project of introducing OP-NOS training as a compulsory training with students of the University. The MOU will be signed 2014 September 23, at Chandrasekhar Auditorium in Pune University Campus. As per the agreed terms of the MOU, the

skill training of SECURITY and nine more sectors has been made mandatory for Post Graduate students. Dr. Gade, Vice Chancellor of the Pune University will launch the project on 23rd September in presence of NSDC SSC officials. leaders Principals of 567 colleges who will be project orientation and roll out plan at a workshop to be held on September 12, 2014.

The brief highlights of the project are as under:

- □ QP-NOS based courses will be introduced for almost 1 lakh Post Graduate students spread over 567 Colleges from this academic year. Next year it will be spread to over 7 lakh students of the University covering both PG and UG.
- ☐ The 567 colleges are spread across Pune, Nasik, Ahmednagar and Dadar & Nagar Haveli.
- □ QP-NOS based skill training is being made mandatory for all PG students of the University and 10 credits have been allocated to it during the academic cycle.
- □ Pilot project will be launched on 23rd Sep in select colleges and cascade to other colleges in next 30 days time frame.
